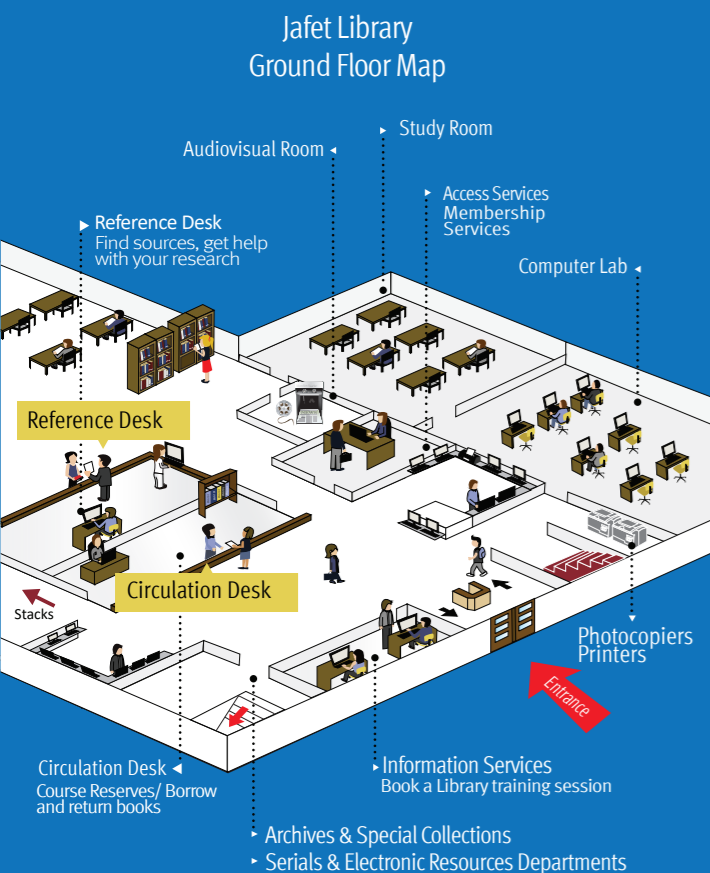

The University Libraries acquire, organize and provide access to resources in all formats necessary to support the educational mission of AUB. They provide online search tools to help users retrieve relevant and reliable information. Librarians assist patrons in searching and finding relevant library resources.

Resources we offer

- More than **400.000** print books / **800.000** e-books
- More than **10.000** print journals / **190.000** e-journals
- More than **405** multidisciplinary and specialized databases
- Hundreds of reference books, print and electronic
- A large audiovisual collection of CDs, videos and DVDs
- Microfilm historical collections of journals and newspapers going back to the 1800's
- Archives and Special Collections, **954** Archival linear feet; more than **1,800** manuscripts; **5,000** posters; **2,000** maps; **72,000** photographs and **800** postcards
- AUB theses, projects and dissertations
- Course Reading Reserves and previous exams

Search tools

- **SearchAll** A one-stop search tool across the Libraries' print and online collections including full-text articles, books, theses, encyclopedias, etc.
- **Catalog** Find books, journals, theses, videos and other materials in the University Libraries
- **Databases** Find and access online articles and other material in your field
- **Journal Finder** Find and access individual journals
- **e-Books** Find and access e-books
- **Research Guides** Find resources on specific subjects
- **Institutional Repository** Find AUB scholarly publications and open data
